INTRODUCTION

The Economic Journal of Nepal is a research-oriented quarterly of the Central Department of economics, Tribhuvan University, devoted to the study of economic and social development with emphasis on the problems of Nepal. With the publication of research papers and articles, the Journal has been playing significant role in the enrichment of the Economic literature of Nepal.

It is interesting to note that the Journal had its beginning with the title 'Economic Monthly'. The first three issues came out bimonthly. It was only from its fourth issue that the Journal got the present title 'The Economic Journal of Nepal' and the publication schedule became quarterly. Since than, the Journal is being published regularly. Commenced in November, 1977, the Journal completed thirteen years of its publication in December 1990. During this period, the Journal published in all 287 articles and 45 book-reviews. An attempt has been made here to prepare a systematic bibliography of all these articles and book-reviews so that these can be easily accessible to students and researchers for their study and research.

In the present bibliography, all the articles are arranged systematically by subject according to the Dewey Decimal Scheme, and to this classified list, are appended Author-Title Index, Keyword/Subject Index and the Author-entries of Book Reviews. It is thus a comprehensions index to the journal, designed to help the students easily search information in the volumes of the journal. If you want information on 'Basic Needs', 'Inflation' or any other specific topic contained in the Journal, the Subject/Keyword Index will help you easily find material you require; on the other hand, if your interest is on the articles of some author, please refer to the Author-Title Index for the information of your choice. Although this Index is prepared mainly for the use of the students of M.A. Economics, I believe, it will be of interest to anyone involved in the study and research of Economics of Nepal.
