ChatGPT has shown to be more advantageous in some aspects. Its ability to produce more refined sentences surpasses those of the unedited ones. It is capable of providing an edited paragraph within seconds and, currently, it is available for free to everyone.

Following the necessary corrections and additions resulting from the review process the twenty accepted papers were included in the issue covering the specific areas of Nepali, English, Sanskrit, Economics, Education, Science and Management.

The journal strictly follows the guidelines of APA 7th ed. as well as strongly opposes plagiarized contents without proper citation as per plagiarism software named iThenticate.

All manuscripts once published becomes the property of the publisher. We hope that inspiration and encouragement from the readers will continue to keep the *Dristikon* alive and developing.
